Eligibility:

Artist must be a resident of Pennsylvania. Work must have been created within the past three (3) years.

Categories:

- **Craft:** Functional or decorative three-dimensional craft in any synthetic or natural media.
- **Painting:** Oil, acrylic, watercolor, or mixed media, painted on a two-dimensional surface.
- **Photography:** Black and white, color, or digital photography.
- **Sculpture:** Carved, molded, or constructed three-dimensional art, hard or soft [12 foot limit].
- **Works on paper:** Prints, drawings, pastels, or mixed media on paper.

Selection:

- Jurors will select work to be exhibited from digital or slide images.

ENTRY PROCEDURES:

Digital Image Submission Guidelines

- Standard jpg. Image: each jpg should be captured by a digital camera at high resolution at 300 dpi onto a CD.
- Submit one (1) jpg image for each painting, photograph or work on paper in a **PC compatible format**, not larger than 25 megabytes.
- For 3-D (three-dimensional) craft and sculpture, you may submit up to three jpgs (front, back and side views), if you wish, for each work.
- Clearly write on the CD label: artist's name, title, entry form list number (1, 2 or 3), medium and dimensions (in inches, height x width).
- **Images and/or Entry Forms sent via email WILL NOT be accepted.**
- CDs will NOT be returned, unless a self-addressed, stamped envelope is enclosed.

Slide Submission Guidelines *(If you do not have access to digital technology)*

- Submit one (1) slide for each painting, work on paper, or photograph.

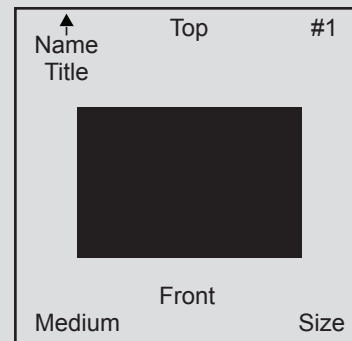

Notification of Acceptance

All artists will be notified of the judging results by mail, no later than April 30. Details for delivering or shipping of accepted work will be included in the letter. At the discretion of the Museum curator, the artist may be responsible for installation of art, if assemblage or other special conditions exist.

- For three-dimensional sculpture and craft, you may submit up to three (3) slides (front, back and side views, if desired) for each work.
- Slides WILL NOT be returned to you, unless a self-addressed, stamped envelope is enclosed with your entry form.
- Each 2 in. x 2 in., 35 mm slide must be clearly labeled with the following information: artist name, entry number, title, medium and dimensions, and indicate the top of the slide.



ARTIST'S CHECKLIST:

- Completed and signed Entry Form.
- Price/insurance value must be noted, even if work is not for sale.
- Correctly labeled CD or slides.
- Check for \$25.00, payable to The Greater Harrisburg Arts Council, for each category entered. There will be a \$25.00 charge for returned checks.
- Self-addressed, stamped envelope for return of CD or slides.

AWARDS:

More than \$7000 will be awarded in cash prizes. The Greater Harrisburg Arts Council awards the following in each of the five categories:

- First Prize: \$500
- Second Prize: \$300
- Third Prize: \$200

Rose Roy Award Honoring Volunteerism: \$250
William D. Davis Memorial Award for Drawing: \$250
The State Museum Purchase Award: up to \$2000.

Notification of Awards

Awards are chosen in June, after the accepted works have been delivered and installed at The State Museum.

Award recipients will be contacted, prior to the opening reception/awards ceremony on June 26. A statewide press release, announcing the awards will be sent out by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.
