FOUR SEASONS

3D TREE TEMPLATE

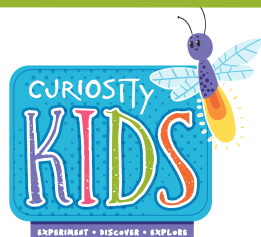
Celebrate the four seasons! Trees are a great indicator of which season we are experiencing. During spring, trees will bud and flower. In summer, trees are full of leaves. While in autumn, the leaves will turn fall colors and fall to the ground. And in winter... the branches are bare and covered with snow and ice. Watch the trees change throughout the year.

MATERIALS

- Cardstock
- Tree template
- Computer Printer
- Scissors
- Quick dry glue

OPTIONAL MATERIALS

- Markers, crayons
- Paint
- Tissue paper, cotton balls, animal or seasonal stickers

INSTRUCTIONS

1

Print out four copies of the tree template on cardstock and cut out the trees.



Color or paint trees templates specific for each season.

On the indicated line, fold all four trees with the colored side inside the fold.

Glue each tree to the next tree cutout in the following order:

- attach right half of Spring tree to left half of Summer tree
- attach right half of Summer tree to left half of Autumn tree
- attach right half of Autumn tree to left half of Winter tree
- link all four together by attaching right half of Winter tree to left half of Spring Tree
- tree should stand upright on its own



Optional:

Add 3D decoration as desired, using materials like stickers, tissue paper and cotton balls to further represent each of the seasons.
